She has developed plans to manage sensitive habitats and to mitigate for impacts to sensitive species. She believes in seeking ways that human land-use activities and natural resources can co-exist.

Ms. Schettler is also a licensed landscape contractor. She has developed and implemented revegetation plans and erosion control plans for disturbed sites of common and uncommon native plant species. She has led teams that satisfactorily carried out revegetation contracts for public agencies and municipalities (Public Works Departments, Caltrans, University of California, City of Saratoga, Fort Ord Reuse Authority, Santa Clara Valley Water District) as well as for corporations and private clients. Her work has helped clients obtain permits from agencies such as the Regional Water Quality Control Board, California Department of Fish and Game, State Mining and Geology Board, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, California Coastal Commission, and county Planning Departments.

Ms. Schettler's combined background in consulting and contracting brings a uniquely practical approach to her work in the restoration and management of native biological resources. She has a special expertise in the ecology of the Sandhills and revegetation of quarries – uncommonly challenging sites.
